- ¹ Now after the Sabbath, at the dawning toward the first *day* of the week, Mary the Magdalene and the other Mary came to look on the burial place.
- ² (And look! A great earthquake happened, for an angel of the Lord descended from heaven, came up and¹ rolled away the stone, and was sitting on it.

³ (And his look was as lightning, and his clothing white as snow.

- ⁴ (And from fear of him, those keeping *watch* quaked and became as dead *men*.)
- ⁵ And in response,² the angel said to the women, "You stop being afraid, for I know that *it is* Jesus, the crucified one, *whom* you seek.
- ⁶ "He is not here, for He was raised, just as He said! Come here, see the place where He was laid.
- ⁷ "And quickly go,³ tell His disciples, 'He was raised from the dead And look! He precedes you into Galilee! There, You will see Him!' Look, I said *this* to you."

⁸ And they went away quickly from the tomb with fear and great (Matthew 28:1-15 Pastor Phi joy, and⁴ ran to report *it* to His disciples.

- ⁹ And look! Jesus met them, saying, "Greetings!"⁵ And they came up and⁶ grasped His feet, and worshipped Him.
- ¹⁰ Then Jesus says to them, "Stop being afraid! Go, report to My brothers that they should go away into Galilee, and there they will see Me."
- ¹¹ And while they were going, look! some of the guard of soldiers came into the city and⁷ reported to the chief priests all the things which had happened.
- ¹² And after gathering together with the elders and taking counsel together, they gave an adequate *amount of* silver to the soldiers,
- ¹³ saying, "Say, 'His disciples by night came and⁷ stole Him, while we were sleeping."
- ¹⁴ "And if this be heard before the governor, we ourselves will persuade him, and you we will make unanxious."
- ¹⁵ And they took the silver and⁸ did as they were taught. And this word was spread among Jews, until this very day.
